

Uniform Policy

Introduction

This policy has been developed following a collaborative process involving parents, staff and the Board of Management. It is the policy of the school that all children will wear our agreed uniform each day. This fosters a feeling of belonging to our community and helps to develop our student's self confidence and self-esteem.

The school uniform is to be worn on all school days unless parents are notified of a change in advance. On P.E. days children wear their school tracksuit.

Red v-neck jumper with school crest	Black tracksuit jumper with school crest
White shirt	Red collared t-shirt
Black trousers / skirt	Black tracksuit bottoms
Runners / Shoes	Runners

Pre-crested jumpers and tracksuits are available to purchase from Richie Whelan Menswear, Main Street, Naas. Alternatively, crests can be purchased from the school office and attached to generic uniforms.

Other Considerations

- Please ensure that all uniform items are labelled clearly with your child's name.
- Runners must be suitable for P.E. activities i.e. flat soles with suitable foot support.
- During good weather students are permitted to substitute black shorts for trousers/skirt.
- Stud earrings and a watch are the only permitted jewellery.
- Makeup is not permitted.
