

Absence Report to Tusla

Under the Education (Welfare) Act, 2000 the law states that every child between the ages of 6 and 16 must attend school or otherwise receive an education.

Taking holidays during term time means that children miss important school time. We strongly advise parents not to take their children out of school for holidays during term time.

Please be aware that if your child misses 20 days or more in a school year the school must report it to Tusla. It is very important that you update the reason for any absences for your child on Aladdin.








M. Miriam's Class

The we went to the new library and sang songs and listened to stories!




Then we got to meet some paramedics who showed us what is inside an ambulance!
