**All transfer applications to Senior Infants, First Class, Second Class, Third Class, Fourth Class, Fifth Class or Sixth Class in Naas CNS, will only be accepted from the 11/04/25. The closing date for receipt of applications is the 02/05/25. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.**

<b>Successful applicants to the Junior Infants must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission to Naas CNS by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:</b>	13/12/2024

All transfer applicants from Senior Infants to 6 <sup>th</sup> class will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	16/05/2025
Successful transfer applicants from Senior Infants to 6 <sup>th</sup> class must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission to Naas CNS by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	30/05/25
